RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for Copying Old Records of the Towns of Penobscot, Sedgwick and Brooksville.

Copying old records, provided for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$250 to be paid to the Brooksville Historical Society for the purpose of copying old records of the towns of Penobscot, Sedgwick and Brooksville, the work to be done under the direction of an experienced research worker with an assistant; said sum to be taken from the general funds of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

It is desired to make a copy of the old town books of the towns of Penobscot, Sedgwick and Brooksville from their beginning to the year 1875. All records will be carefully checked and re-checked, typed and put in convenient form for use.
