STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

RESOLVE, for the Purchase of Indian Relics from the Penobscot Tribe of Indians.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, certain Indian relics have been discovered on Old Town Indian Island which have historical value, and

Whereas, these should be preserved for posterity, and

Whereas, at the present time these are being sold for little or nothing, and will not be available, and

Whereas, in the opinion of the legislature, these facts render the immediate passage of this act necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and constitute an emergency within the meaning of section 16 of Article XXXI of the constitution; now therefore, be it

Resolved: That the sum of \$500 be, and hereby is, appropriated for the purchase of Indian relics from members of the Penobscot Indian tribe by the library board of the Old Town library, and to be deposited with the Old Town librarian, and cared for by him for the benefit of the public.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble this resolve shall take effect when approved.
