AN ACT Relating to the Election of Members of the Public Utilities Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 62, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 62 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence thereof and substituting the following:

'The Public Utilities Commission as heretofore established, shall consist of 3 members appointed by the governor, with the advice and consent of the council, from time to time upon the expiration of the terms of the several members, for terms of 7 years. The public utilities commission, as heretofore established, shall consist of 3 members, nominated and elected in the same manner as the governor, the first election of which shall be at the biennial election in 1941 at which time there shall be elected 1 member to serve for 2 years, 1 member to serve for 4 years and 1 member to serve for 6 years. At each biennial election thereafter 1 member shall be elected to serve for 6 years.'
