STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to State Owned Automobiles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Use of state owned cars; penalty. All motor vehicles owned by the state or any department thereof shall be used and operated only in the business of the state as department concerned. Use by any state employee for the purpose of commuting or going from or to his house or residence, to or from his office at the state house, or other place of business or use by his family or agent other than in the sole business of the state or department is hereby prohibited except on specific written authorization of the departmental head. For any unauthorized use of such motor vehicle the party using the same shall pay said state or department 5c for each mile so used and continued violation of this act shall result in the dismissal of the offender from his employment as provided in chapter 221 of the public laws of 1937. Departmental heads shall be responsible for the enforcement of this act.
