**AN ACT Relating to Increase in the Salary of the Judge of the Caribou
Municipal Court.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1915, c. 17, amended. Chapter 17 of the private and special laws of 1915 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 17. Salary of judge; statement; payment of fees; cost. The judge of said municipal court shall receive as compensation a salary of ~~one thousand dollars~~ **\$2000** a year to be paid quarterly from the treasury of the county of Aroostook. A condition preceding the payment of said salary as aforesaid, shall be the rendering by said judge of a correct statement to the county commissioners and the payment over by said judge to the county treasurer, of all fees both civil and criminal collected by said municipal court for the preceding quarter or fractional part thereof. All costs in criminal cases shall be taxed the same, and paid into court in the same manner as in trial justice courts, except that every warrant issued by said judge shall be taxed at \$1.'
