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**AN ACT Relating to Motor Vehicle Operators.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., c. 29, § 33, amended.** The first sentence of section 33 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Applications to operate motor vehicles shall be presented by mail or otherwise to the secretary of state upon blanks prepared under his authority, and which shall therein call for specific answers to questions of a character designed to show the experience and competency of the applicant to operate a motor vehicle; a fee of ~~two dollars~~ \$2.50 shall accompany the application.'

**Sec. 2. R. S., c. 29, § 33, amended.** Section 33 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes as amended is hereby further amended by inserting at the end thereof the following:

'The secretary of state shall pay to the treasurer of state 50c from each license fee received from applicants for licenses to operate motor vehicles. The funds so received by the state treasurer shall become a part of the general funds of the state of Maine.'
