STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Registration Fees of Motor Vehicles.

Emergency preamble: Whereas, a readjustment of fees for the registration of motor vehicles is necessary and expedient and the enactment of the following provisions would be of benefit to the people of this state, and

Whereas, motor vehicle registrations and license number plates issued thereunder during the calendar year of 1938 are valid for use and display until March 1, 1939, and

Whereas, in order to make the provisions of this act effective to all registrants of motor vehicles on and after March 1, 1939, to be effective for the year 1939, it is necessary that this act become effective immediately, and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature these facts create an emergency within the meaning of section 16 of Article XXXI of the constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 29, § 54, amended. The 3rd paragraph of section 54 of chapter 29 is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'o horse power to and including 17 horse power	\$10
18 horse power to and including 24 horse power	12
25 horse power to and including 30 horse power	14
31 horse power and over	16

Sec. 2. P. L., 1937, c. 249, repealed. Chapter 249 of the public laws of 1937 is hereby repealed.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble hereof, this act shall take effect when approved.
