AN ACT Relating to Poll-Taxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 13, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 13 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 1. Poll-tax. R. S., c. 10, § 1, 1921, c. 42. A poll-tax shall be assessed upon every ~~male~~ inhabitant of the state above the age of ~~twenty-one~~ 21 years whether a citizen of the United States or an alien, in the manner provided by law unless ~~he is~~ exempted therefrom by this chapter, which said poll-tax shall be three dollars.'
