IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Retirement Pension.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Retirement pensions. All state officers and employees who are entitled to retire upon a pension, shall upon arriving at the age of 70 years retire on or before their 71st birthday or forfeit all rights to such pension. If any officer or employee has reached the age of 71 years at the time this act takes effect, if he or she retires within 6 months after this act takes effect, he or she shall, if otherwise entitled thereto, be entitled to receive such pension.
