#### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

#### AN ACT Relating to Accounting by Charitable Organizations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Examination. Any organization, whether incorporated or voluntary, which receives contributions by solicitation, or from investments, or from both, which in the aggregate amounts to a sum of \$50,000 or more, shall cause to be examined by a certified public accountant, annually, their accounts which shall include all receipts and disbursements, all in detail. Upon completion of such examination, such accountant shall make a detailed report of his findings and file the same with said organization.
- Sec. 2. Publication. The said organization shall cause to be published annually for 2 or more weeks successively in a newspaper printed and published within the county where such organization has its principal office a resume of such examination, the first publication to be within 2 weeks next following the receipt of such findings.
