AN ACT Relative to Trapping Muskrats.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 38, § 72, amended. Paragraph (b) of section 72 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows :

‘Provided, further, that it shall be unlawful for any person to set or place a trap at any time within 25 feet of, or to molest or destroy, a muskrat house or den, and no person shall make any advance preparation on the trapping grounds, previous to the time the open season begins.’
