STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Hunting Foxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 38, § 75, amended. Section 75 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:
- **'Sec. 75.** Digging out raccoons, regulated. From the 15th day of February to the 15th day of October, both days inclusive, no person shall dig out, molest, or destroy, in any way, any fox or raccoon den, den tree or hole, or set any trap in any such den, den tree, or hole, or remove or cause to be removed from any such den, den tree, or hole any fox or raccoon except those enclosed in private fox or raccoon ranches.'
- Sec. 2. R. S., c. 38, additional. Chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding a new section to be numbered 75-A, and to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 75-A. Digging out foxes, regulated. From the 15th day of February to the 15th day of November, both days inclusive, no person shall dig out, molest, or destroy, in any way, any fox den, den tree or hole, or set any trap in any such den, den tree, or hole, or remove or cause to be removed from any such den, den tree, or hole any fox except those enclosed in private fox ranches.'
