STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN AC Relative to Power-Boats in Hunting Waterfowl.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 38, § 59, amended. Section 59 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended, to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 59. Use of power-boats in hunting waterfowl prohibited. No person shall at any time hunt, pursue or molest any sea birds, duck or waterfowl in any inland or tidal waters of the state from an automobile, airplane, power-boat, sailboat, any boat under sail, any floating device towed by a power-boat or any boat propelled by a motor attached in any manner.'
