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**AN ACT** Relating to Tuition for Indian Scholars in the Elementary Schools  
of Old Town.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. L., 1933, c. 1, § 265, amended.** Section 265 of chapter 1 of the public laws of 1933, as amended by section 1 of chapter 146 of the public laws of 1933, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

‘Tuition likewise for the children of Indian Island who attend the elementary schools of Old Town shall be paid to said town by the department of education in similar manner and based on the average instructional cost per pupil in the year preceding that for which tuition is paid.’
