**AN ACT Relating to the Disposal of the Receipts on the Ferry at Indian
Island.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Receipts of tribal ferry to be deposited with the tribal treasurer. All moneys collected from the operation of the ferry that operates from Indian Island to the mainland shall be paid over to the treasurer of the Penobscot tribe and all expenses incidental to the operation of said ferry shall be paid on the approval of the governor and the council of said Penobscot tribe.
