RESOLVE, in Favor of the Pownal State School.

Necessary buildings for Pownal state school provided for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$21,000 in favor of the Pownal state school to be expended by the department of health and welfare for the purpose of building 3 cottages for the housing of employees of said school.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This money is desired to build suitable quarters for the employees of the Pownal state school.
