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**RESOLVE**, in Favor of the Maine Division of the Women's Field Army  
of the American Society for Control of Cancer.

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**American Society for Control of Cancer; appropriation for. Resolved:**  
That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the Women's Field Army of the American Society for Control of Cancer, the sum of \$25,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1940, and \$25,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1941; said sums to be paid from the general funds of the state.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

These appropriations are needed to pay for treatment by radium or diagnosis and treatment by X-ray of indigent cancer patients in the state.
