AN ACT Relating to Use of Trailers on Farm Tractors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 29, § 54, amended. The 5th paragraph of subdivision lettered (b) of section 54 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Farm tractors or trailers attached thereto used for agricultural purposes or not customarily used on public ways shall pay one-tenth of the above rates; caterpillar tractors, so-called, except as above provided, shall pay a registration fee of \$15 except that, when so constructed as to carry a load, they shall be rated as trucks.'
