AN ACT Relating to Powers of County Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 92, additional. Chapter 92 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new section to be numbered 28, and to read as follows :

'Sec. 28. Powers of county commissioners. The county commissioners of the several counties in the state may, without obtaining the consent of their respective counties, appropriate any sum, not exceeding one mill on a dollar, based on the valuation of the preceding year, to be expended and used for advertising the natural resources, advantages, and attractions of the state, or said county.'
