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**AN ACT Relating to Filing Referendum Petitions.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**Fee of clerk.** Upon the presentation for verifications under the provisions of section 17 and 18 of the constitution of Maine to the clerk of the city, town or plantation in which the petitioners reside, the person, persons or organization in whose behalf such petition is presented shall pay to such clerk for his examination and certification thereof the sum of \$.005 per name thereon as a petitioner before he shall examine such petition.
