**AN ACT Relating to Seizure of Motor Vehicles Transporting Stolen
Property.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Transportation by motor vehicle of stolen property. Whoever, by any motor vehicle or trailer thereto attached, owned by him, knowingly transports from place to place in the state any stolen property, and whoever permits the motor vehicle or trailer thereto attached, owned by him so to be used in the transportation of stolen property shall forfeit such motor vehicle and trailer to the state.

Sec. 2. Forms. The forms set forth in section 44 of chapter 137 of the revised statutes relating to the seizure and libel of automobiles for illegal transportation of intoxicating liquors, with such changes as adapt them to the purposes set forth in section 1 hereof, for all cases arising thereunder, are sufficient in law.
