AN ACT Relating to the Taxation of Stock.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 13, § 6, ¶ VI, amended. Paragraph VI of section 6 of chapter 13 of the revised statutes as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

‘VI. All mules and horses less than 6 months old, and all colts of draught type under 3 years old, and neat cattle 18 months old ~~and~~ or under, owned or kept for the purpose of future breeding and sale; all mules and horses to the number of 4, owned or kept for use in the business of farming, all neat cattle to the number of 25 owned or kept for the purpose of producing milk, and all sheep to the number of ~~35~~ 50, and swine to the number of 10 and domestic fowl to the number of ~~50~~ 100.’
