AN ACT Relating to Assessors in Taking Inventory.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 12, § 19, amended. Section 19 of chapter 12 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following is enacted in place thereof :

‘Sec. 19. Assessors to include in inventory sheep, swine, neat cattle, and fowl; returns to bureau of taxation. Assessors of taxes shall include in the inventory, required to be taken on April 1st, the number and value of all mules and horses less than 6 months old, and neat cattle 18 months old and under, kept for future breeding and sale, all mules and horses to the number of 4 kept for farming purposes, all neat cattle to the number of 25, all sheep to the number of 10 and domestic fowl to the number of 100, stated separately. Said property shall not be included in the tax list.’
