**RESOLVE, Providing for a Survey for the Location of a Road Along
Upper Richardson Lake.**

Road along Upper Richardson Lake; survey provided for. Resolved: That the state highway commission be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to lay out a road making the proper survey and plan therefor, beginning at the point to which a survey was authorized in 1937 and thence extending to the Wilson's Mills road. There is hereby appropriated from the general highway fund the sum of \$500 for said survey, which is to be expended under the supervision of the state highway commission.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Such a road will open up a region for development to quite an extent.
