**AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the County Treasurer of Aroostook  
County and the Clerk Hire in the Office of said Treasurer.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**Sec. 1. R. S., c. 125, § 45, amended.** Section 45 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes is hereby amended so that the first five lines read as follows :

‘County treasurers in the several counties shall receive annual salaries from the treasuries of the counties in monthly payments paid on the last day of each month, as follows :

Androscoggin, two thousand dollars,

Aroostook, ~~eight hundred dollars,~~ \$1500,’

**Sec. 2. R. S., c. 125, § 46, amended.** The third paragraph of section 46 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows :

‘Aroostook county: for clerks in the office of register of deeds of the northern district, \$1300; for clerks in the office of register of deeds for the southern district \$3700; for clerks in the office of register of probate, \$1560; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts \$2600; for clerks in the office of

the county attorney, \$600; ~~for clerks in the office of county treasurer, three hundred dollars;~~ for expenses of clerk of courts and his subordinates while attending sessions of the superior court at Caribou, such sums as allowed by the court.'

This act to become effective January 1, 1939.
