RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey the Timber and Grass on a Lot in Little Squaw Township.

Forest commissioner authorized to convey timber and grass in Squaw township. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to the Maine Lumber Company, the interest of the state in and to the timber and grass on public lot, T. 3, R. 5, B.K.P.E.K.R. in Little Squaw Township in Piscataquis county, the same comprising 255 acres; also, the state abates and discharges all its claims for taxes thereon. The consideration for the foregoing is that said grantee shall, as soon as possible after this resolve becomes effective, commence and perform in good faith, lumbering operations on said lot and thereby give gainful employment to many of the citizens of the state.
