**AN ACT Relating to the Use of Marijuana.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 129, additional.** Chapter 129 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding a new section thereto to be numbered 39-A, and to read as follows:

**'Sec. 39-A. Distribution of marijuana prohibited; penalty. No person, firm or corporation shall sell, produce or give away marijuana in any form either in cigarettes or in any other combination of materials. Any person charged with violating the provisions of this section and arrested under due process shall be held without bail until final disposition of the case. Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be punished by imprisonment for life.'**
