IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Hours of State House Employees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Hours of state house employees regulated. The offices of each department of the state in the state house shall be opened from Monday to and including Friday of each week, and shall be closed on Saturday and Sunday. Provided, however, that in case of necessity any department office may be kept open for the transaction of extra business.
