STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Taxation of Personal Property.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Taxation of personal property. Any person going into any town in this state, and taking with him any property upon which a tax has not been assessed and paid elsewhere for that year, and doing business therein with such property after the 1st day of April and before the 1st day of September of any year, shall be taxed on such property in the town in which the property is located.
