IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Taxes Assessed upon Homes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Rate of taxation. No tax shall be assessed upon any land with the buildings thereon, the use of which is solely for residential purposes by the owners, and not for rental or other revenue producing purposes, on fair valuation exceeding \$25 for each \$1000 for the first \$4000 value.
