AN ACT Relating to Exemptions from Taxation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 13, § 6, ¶ IX, amended. Paragraph IX of section 6 of chapter 13 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

‘Any city, town, or plantation may file with the governor and council a true list of all persons residing in said city, town, or plantation receiving exemptions from taxation under the terms of this paragraph, together with a statement of the amount of said exemptions. The governor and council shall examine said list and statement, and, having verified them, shall certify them to the treasurer of state who shall thereupon pay to said city, town, or plantation from the treasury of the state, the amount the said city, town, or plantation has lost in taxation by reason of said exemptions.’
