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**RESOLVE, Creating a Recess Committee on Feasibility of Acquiring  
Property for the Establishment of Public Bathing Beaches.**

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**Recess committee, created. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, created a legislative committee to consist of 2 members of the senate to be appointed by the president of the senate, and 3 members of the house to be appointed by the speaker of the house, to investigate the feasibility of the acquisition by purchase or gift by the state of property adjacent to the waters of the state for the purpose of establishing public bathing beaches. Said committee shall make a written report of its findings and recommendations to the 90th legislature, and in the event that said committee finds it desirable that such legislation be enacted, it shall draft a bill or bills for that purpose and cause the same to be presented to the 90th legislature. Members of said committee shall receive their actual expenses to be approved by the governor and council.
