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**RESOLVE, Relating to Reimbursement of Licensees Whose Licenses  
Became Inoperative Before the End of the License Period.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Licensees reimbursed. Resolved:** That the treasurer of state is hereby authorized and directed to reimburse all persons, firms and corporations who purchased a license or licenses from the state to distribute, sell or dispense liquors or malt beverages, whose said license or licenses became inoperative because of a local referendum before the expiration of the license period; said reimbursement shall be an amount based on the percentage of the ratio of the time said license or licenses were rendered inoperative as compared to the year for which said license or licenses were issued.
