STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Child Birth.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Expectant mothers to be aided. All expectant mothers, financially unable to secure a physician or hospital care, shall not be pauperized, but shall be provided with proper conveniences and care, and said cost shall be paid by the state, from the appropriation for the department of health and welfare.
