IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Evidence in Criminal Cases.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Scientific analysis of body fluids admissible as evidence in certain cases.
In criminal cases in which the respondent is charged with the operation of a motor vehicle while under the influence of intoxicating liquor, the results of scientific analysis of body fluids legally obtained from the accused shall be admissible as evidence.
