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### AN ACT Relating to Use of Foreign Languages in Schools.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**R. S., c. 19, additional.** Chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding a new section thereto to be numbered 127-A, and to read as follows :

**‘Sec. 127-A. Regulation of instruction in elementary schools. No teacher in any grade or grammar school of the state, whether public, private or parochial, shall conduct classes or give instruction in any language other than the English language.’**
