STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Practice of Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1937, c. 142, amended. Chapter 142 of the public laws of 1937 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

'Any person, firm or corporation other than the principal, who shall draft or assist in the drafting of wills, trust agreements, deeds, mortgages, contracts for purchase and sale of real estate, or in the preparation of any papers or charges to be presented to or made a part of the record of any court of this state shall be deemed to be practicing law within the meaning of this section, whether said services were rendered with or without consideration, direct or indirect.'
