S T A T E O F M A I N E

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Taxation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. L., 1933, c. 244, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 244 of the public laws of 1933, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

‘Any number of separate and distinct lots or parcels of land with a good and sufficient description and valuation of each, together with the amount of the tax assessed upon each of such parcels, all the property of the same owner, may be included in 1 certificate of the lien claimed under the provisions hereof.’

Sec. 2. P. L., 1933, c. 244, § 5, amended. Section 5 of chapter 244 of the public laws of 1933 is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘Sec. 5. Discharge. In the event that said tax, interest and costs upon any 1 or more of said parcels shall be paid within the period of redemption herein provided for, the town treasurer shall discharge said mortgage as to such parcel or lots in the same manner as is now provided for the discharge of real estate mortgages without in any way affecting the validity.’
