STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Motor Vehicle Registration and Operators' Fees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 29, § 54, amended. Section 54 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the end of subdivision lettered (a) the following:

'But a certificate of registration, without a fee, shall be issued to persons engaged in farming, to operate their motor vehicles upon the highways for a distance not exceeding I mile from the farm they are operating; no excise tax shall be required for the registration of such vehicles.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 29, § 33, amended. Section 33 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the end of the second sentence thereof the following:

'But a license, without fee, shall be issued to persons engaged in farming, to operate motor vehicles upon the highway for a distance not exceeding I mile from the farm they are operating.'
