RESOLVE, Granting Authority to the Forestry Department to Convey Certain Land to Alex J. Latno, of Old Town.

Forestry department authorized to convey certain land. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to convey the following described lot to Alex J. Latno, of Old Town, for the sum of \$66.51: 143 acres of land in township I North Division (formerly Summit Plantation) Penobscot county.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This land, reputed to be owned by Alex J. Latno of Old Town, was acquired by the forest commissioner in behalf of the state in 1936 for 1934 taxes. Mr. Latno is desirous of redeeming this lot by paying the taxes in arrears. The taxes in arrears with interest and advertising to April 1, 1939 amount to \$66.51. Check for this amount is now in the hands of the state tax assessor.
