STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Age Limits of State Employees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

State departments not to discriminate against applicants for employment because of advanced age. No official, department, bureau or other administrative agency of the state shall make any regulation whereby any applicant for employment by the state shall be ineligible for such employment because of advanced age.
