STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Fees for Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

License fees may be reduced or suspended. Whenever there is accumulated, or shall hereafter accumulate, in the state treasury to the account of any board or commission charged with the duty of issuing licenses for the conduct of any profession, trade or business, sums of money in excess of the amount required properly to cover the expense of performing the duties imposed upon such board or commission in connection with the granting of such licenses and the supervision of persons licensed, said board or commission with the approval of the governor and council may suspend the payment or reduce the amount of any license fees fixed by statute until in the opinion of such board or commission it shall be necessary to collect the full amount thus established by law.
