**AN ACT Relating to Exemption from Taxation of Property of Blind
Persons.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 13, § 6, ¶ IX, amended. Paragraph IX of section 6 of chapter 13 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

‘Provided, however, that such exemption from taxation of property owned by blind persons shall not apply to those whose kindred are liable for their support under the provisions of section 15 of chapter 33; the same kindred so liable for their support are hereby made liable for the payment of the taxes assessed upon the property of such blind persons, which may be recovered by the town in which the property is situated by complaint to the superior court in the same maner as provided by section 16 of chapter 33.’
