AN ACT Relating to the Western Hancock Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1893, c. 613, amended. Chapter 613 of the private and special laws of 1893, as amended by chapter 26 of the private and special laws of 1919, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 20. Salary of judge increased. From and after July 1st, ~~nineteen hundred nineteen~~ 1939 the judge of said court shall receive as compensation an annual salary of ~~seven hundred and fifty dollars~~ \$1000, to be paid monthly from the treasury of the county of Hancock together with actual expenses incurred by him in the trial of criminal cases in any town other than that in which said judge may reside; and in addition thereto said judge shall receive for every blank writ signed by him, 5c; for entry of each civil action, ~~sixty cents~~ 50c; taxing costs and recording judgment, 25c; writ of execution or possession, 15c. The judge shall receive for every warrant issued by him, \$1, which together with all costs and fines received by him in criminal cases shall, within 60 days after receipt thereof, be by him paid into the treasury of the county of Hancock.'
