RESOLVE, Relating to Digging for Clams in Biddeford.

Digging for clams in Biddeford, regulated. Resolved: Notwithstanding the provisions of section 52 of chapter 2 of the public laws of 1933, rule and regulation 39 of the sea and shore fisheries rules and regulations, shall be effective unless the department after public hearing and study of actual tests shall determine that said flats are contaminated, in which case they shall order the discontinuance of said rule and regulation.
