**RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for Drilling Artesian Wells in the Town
of Perry.**

Artesian wells at Pleasant Point Reservation. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$3000 to be expended under the direction of the department of health and welfare for the drilling of 1 to 3 artesian wells in Pleasant Point Reservation in the town of Perry; said sum to be paid from the general funds.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The most of the wells at the reservation have been condemned as containing water unfit for human consumption.
