STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the State Police.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 29, § 126, amended. The 1st sentence of section 126 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The governor and council shall determine the salary salaries of the chief and deputy chief and the compensation of the other members of the state police shall be determined as follows:

On appointment as a patrolman, the member shall receive a salary of \$20 per week. Annually upon recommendation of the commanding officer of his district, each patrolman shall receive an increase in salary of \$1.50 per week until his pay shall reach the sum of \$35 per week.

On appointment as a sergeant, the member shall receive a salary of \$36 per week. Annually upon recommendation of the commanding officer of his district, each sergeant shall receive an increase in salary of \$26 per year until his pay shall reach the sum of \$38 per week.

On appointment as a lieutenant, the member shall receive a salary of \$40 per week. Annually upon recommendation of the commanding officer, each

lieutenant shall receive an increase in salary of \$1 per week until his pay shall reach the sum of \$53 per week.

On appointment as a captain, the member shall receive a salary of \$47 per week. Annually upon recommendation of the commanding officer, each captain shall receive an increase in salary of \$1 per week until his pay shall reach the sum of \$58 per week.'

Sec. 2. Saving clause. No part of this act shall be construed to reduce the present compensation of any member of the state police.
