STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Nobleboro.

Town of Nobleboro; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$191.50 to be paid to the town of Nobleboro, to compensate it for sheep killed by dogs in the years 1929 and 1930; said sum to be paid from the division of animal industry damage by dogs funds.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This is money that the town of Nobleboro paid in the years 1929 and 1930 to residents of the town for sheep and lambs killed by dogs.

There is no record that the town ever received reimbursement by the state for the money so paid, as provided by law, and it now asks that it be reimbursed.
