S T A T E O F M A I N E

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Allen C. Reed and Warren Reed, of Boothbay Harbor.

Allen C. Reed and Warren Reed; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$25 to be paid to Allen C. Reed and Warren Reed, of Boothbay Harbor, to compensate them for towing a dead body to shore; said sum to be paid from the general funds of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This body was found near Sequin on June 5, 1938 and towed to shore at Lobster Cove, Boothbay Harbor. The body was never claimed.
