**RESOLVE, Relating to the Digging of Clams in the Town of Brooklin.**

---

**Digging of clams in town of Brooklin, regulated. Resolved:** That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation prohibiting any person, not an inhabitant of said town of Brooklin, from digging clams for commercial purposes within said town.
